Vulnerable Villages / Hamlets:

- * There has been no history of booth rigging, booth capturing, poll related violence in this territory and the Elections have been held largely in a peaceful manner during the past.
- * The contest for the lone seat has almost always been between two major parties. This gives rise to a situation where smaller population in compact areas vote for either of the political dispensation. The tribal's have also been, historically, voting for any single political dispensation.

- * No Hamlets or villages can be categorized as vulnerable even during normal times due low of no incidence of crimes in almost all parts of the territory.
- * As per the directions of the ECI, no polling stations have been identified as those where the poll percentage was more that 90% and where more than 75% of votes have been recorded in favour of one candidate in the entire UT except for three Polling Stations located in Nicobar District namely
 - a) PS No. 286 (Enam) of Nicobar
 - b) PS No. 289 (Aluroung) of Nicobar
 - c) PS No. 314 (Chingam) of Nicobar
- * No violence or incidents of booth rigging, voter intimidation has been reported in the past or is apprehended.
